Categories / Origin of the data

As part of the employment relationship, we process the following personal data:

Personal Data

- Surname, first name, name addition, date of birth
- Contact details (address, telephone number, email address)
- If applicable, work permit / residence permit
- If necessary, criminal record / certificate of good conduct
- Diplomas and certificates

Your personal data will generally be collected directly from you during the application process.

We also use personally identifiable information that we have legitimately gained from publicly available directories (such as professional networks).

Purposes and legal bases of data processing

When collecting and processing your personal data, the provisions of the EU-GDPR, the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new) and all other (labour-) law provisions are always complied with.

According to Art. 88 (1) EU-GDPR in combination with § 26 (1) German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new), personal data of employees may be processed for employment purposes if this serves the decision to establish an employment relationship or after the employment relationship has been established or terminated.

In addition, a permission to process data, including special categories of personal data, may result from certain other laws, in particular due to industry-specific (compliance) requirements.

Of course, a data protection regulation may also represent your consent to data processing. Here we clarify you about the purpose of the data processing and about your right of withdrawal according to kind 7 paragraph 3 of the EU-GDPR, Art. 88 (1) EU-GDPR in combination with Section 26 (2) German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new), If the consent also relates to the processing of special categories of personal data, we will expressly inform you in the consent, Art. 88 (1) EU-GDPR in combination with Section 26 (3) German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new).

Processing of special categories of personal data within the meaning of Article 9 (1) of the EU GDPR will only take place if this is required by law and there is no reason to believe that your legitimate interest in excluding processing is outweighed, Art. 88 (1) EU-GDPR in combination with Section 26 (3) German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG-new).

Completed if necessary, if a data processing in accordance with a balance of interests acc. Art. 6 (1) part f EU-GDPR's, these should be indicated additionally.

Storage duration of the data

As soon as your data is no longer required for the above purposes, your data will be deleted after a minimum retention period of 6 months after rejection by us. Furthermore, the data will only be stored in cases in which we are obliged or authorized to do so, e.g. if you have given us the permission (in this case for a maximum of 12 months) to store your data for a certain, longer period or to exercise legal rights. Regulations that oblige bdtronic to keep records can be found, for example, in the Commercial Code or in the Tax Code. A retention period can take up to ten years. In addition, limitation periods have to be observed. Should we enter into an employment relationship with you, the relevant applicant data will be stored with us provided that they are still relevant for the employment relationship.

Recipient of the data / categories of recipients

In our company, we ensure that only those departments and individuals receive your application data, which they need to complete the application process. If necessary, applications are forwarded to our subsidiaries in the US or China.

Rights of the person concerned

The rights for you as the person concerned are standardized in Articles 15 - 22 EU-GDPR. This includes:

- The right to information (Article 15 EU-GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Article 16 EU-GDPR)
- The right to cancellation (Article 17 EU-GDPR)
- The right to restriction of processing (Article 18 EU-GDPR)
- The right of objection to the processing (Art. 21 EU-GDPR)
- The right to data portability (Article 20 EU-GDPR)

If we process your data in order to safeguard legitimate interests, you can object to this processing at any time for reasons that arise from your particular situation; this also applies to profiling based on these provisions. We will then no longer process your personal information unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing is intended to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

If we process your personal data for the purpose of direct mail, you have the right to object without giving reasons; this also applies to profiling insofar as it is associated with such direct mail. If you object to the processing for direct marketing purposes, we will no longer process your personal data for these purposes.
